• Stay Hydrated: Drink adequate water throughout the shift to stay hydrated. Water shall be freely available at the Incident Command Post.

• **Sun Protection**: Use sunscreen to be protected from sun exposure. Shade will be available in multiple locations at the event and at the Incident Command Post.

Personal Protective Equipment:

o Hearing Protection - Due to the nature of the event staff will be exposed to loud environments. Please use proper hearing protection when near these areas.

- o Eye Protection Wear appropriate eye protection if respiratory procedures are performed or near a patient with respiratory infection symptoms.
- o Respirator or Surgical Mask A mask shall be worn during any respiratory procedures or when indicated by patient symptoms to prevent exposure to respiratory illness.
- o Gloves Gloves shall be worn at all times during patient care or assisting with medical procedures.
- o High Vis Clothing or Vest If on public roads for an incident high vis clothing or vest shall be worn.
- Vehicle/Driving Safety: During the event staff will have access to a UTV. Drivers shall be properly trained prior to operating the UTV. Before operating the vehicle, the driver shall perform a 360 walk around of the vehicle. Drivers will follow all traffic laws while operating on and off public roads and travel at speeds slow enough to remain in control the vehicle. Proper emergency lighting shall be mounted on the vehicle and used whenever responding or driving near large crowds.
- **Buddy System**: Due to the nature of the event, attendees may be under the influence of drugs or alcohol. When away from command post personnel shall remain in groups of two or more. At times personnel may respond to a heavily populated area, staff should stay together and utilize security or law enforcement for crowd control or when assistance is needed with combative patients. Never enter a scene, indoors or outdoors, unless you know the scene is safe.
- Know Your Surroundings: Familiarize yourself with the event map. Take note of the Incident Command Post, all medical tents and all emergency exits.
- Slip, Trip, Falls: The location of the event will have varying terrain such as roads, grass, and dirt paths. Watch your step when walking on uneven ground. These areas may need to be traversed during night operations therefore use adequate lighting to illuminate walkway hazards.
- Opioid or Other Drug Exposures: Personnel shall be observant to surroundings when away from the command post. Opioid or other drugs may be present on scene of an emergency. Personnel shall be familiar with signs and symptoms of exposure to these substances and proper medical intervention medication shall be made available. Staff may be exposed to the substances even while PPE is donned. If personnel are exposed to these substances all work will cease. Incident commander, and event management shall be notified of the exposure immediately. Medical treatment of personnel is the priority and event work will not continue until staff is medically cleared.

2024 Lightning in a Bottle

Policy, Expectations, and Directives

None of the following Expectations and Directives will supersede or override the Kern Fire Department Policy and Procedure Manual. These Expectations and Directives apply to ALL Fire Department personnel working the 2024 Lightning in a Bottle event.

Code of Conduct Expectations:

- Employees of the Kern County Fire Department **shall not** be photographed with eventgoers or its staff members in an inappropriate or unprofessional context. This includes taking photographs with inappropriately dressed individuals. If asked to take a picture with attendees who are inappropriately dressed, then professionally and gracefully decline.
- Employees of the Kern County Fire Department **shall not** take pictures and/or videos (including personal cell phones) of attendees who are inappropriately dressed.
- Employees assigned a golf cart and/or Rino-like vehicle will conduct an inspection prior to taking possession of and at the end of the shift. Report any damage to the vehicle to IC through the chain of command. Immediately report to the IC through the chain of command any accidents and damage incurred while driving.
- Employees of the Kern County Fire Department are prohibited from providing any statements to the media. If a request is made, then refer the media personnel to the Command Post and notify your supervisor.
- Employees of the Kern County Fire Department will attempt to avoid operating any motor vehicles in any heavily populated areas of the event, unless responding to an emergency. Be sure to remove the keys from the ignition when parking golf carts and Rino's anywhere outside the Command Post.
- All staff are reminded to adhere to the existing social media policy and refrain from posting anything inappropriate to any social media platforms. Including comments and opinions that may reflect the Fire Department in an unprofessional manner. Although freedom of speech does apply, be mindful that you are on-duty and polices apply.
- All employees shall treat all members of the public with respect and dignity throughout the Lightning in a Bottle event.

RULES OF ENGAGEMENT

- Fire Department Actions Incidents;
 - Law Enforcement, Fire, and EMS, will allow LIB to handle most incidents at their level with no intervention unless;
 - Fire Department/County Policy dictates intervention
 - Asked to intervene by LIB staff, or other allied agencies, such as, KC Park Rangers, CHP, County EMS, on-site Fed agencies

Once Law Enforcement, Fire, and/or EMS get involved with or engage in an incident, then Law Enforcement, Fire, and/or EMS reserve the right to exclude LIB from the incident. Law Enforcement, Fire, and EMS have all agreed to conduct the incident according to their respective policies and practices as a unified command.

GENERAL DUTIES OF ALL PERSONNEL

All personnel of the Kern County Fire Department will adhere to all the Rules and Regulations, especially:

- In matters of general conduct, employees shall be governed by the ordinary and reasonable rules of behavior and shall commit no act while on duty that would bring discredit upon the department or its employees. They should advise their immediate supervisor of any significant or unusual conditions existing in the County of Kern.
- Employees shall reasonably govern their personal conduct in order to work harmoniously with their fellow workers.
- Employees shall accord obedience to superiors and respect the rights of subordinates.
- Employees shall keep their person clean and well-groomed and their belongings clean and neatly stored.
- Employees shall not use obscene or uncivil language or engage in any altercation at any place where the department is represented.
- No employee shall accept a reward, fee, or gratuity from any person for services incident to the performance of duty.
- No news releases, public statements, or statistical information concerning department activities will be given out, except by authorized personnel, and only in accordance with the policies set forth by the fire chief. All inquiries for such information shall be directed to the proper officer or authorized personnel.

Note: While working at the event you will be considered on-duty and available to respond county wide, if the need arises. So all PPE should be available even if assigned as FSO
